The role of Learning Mentor enables students to work towards overcoming social, emotional and learning difficulties which act as barriers to learning. They bridge academic and pastoral support roles ensuring that individual pupils and students participate more effectively in their own learning and prepare them well for adult life and independent living. The barriers to learning can be wide ranging and often very personal to the individual pupil. A young person may be going through complex transitions and changes in their own lives, within the family or at college. Learning Mentors help to identify these issues and help them to address what it is that is getting in the way of their learning.

The role includes:

- To provide particular and specific support, interpreting to a Romanian speaking young person.
- Promote acceptance and inclusion of students with special needs within the class.
- Function as a communication link between non-English speaking and limited-English speaking families.
