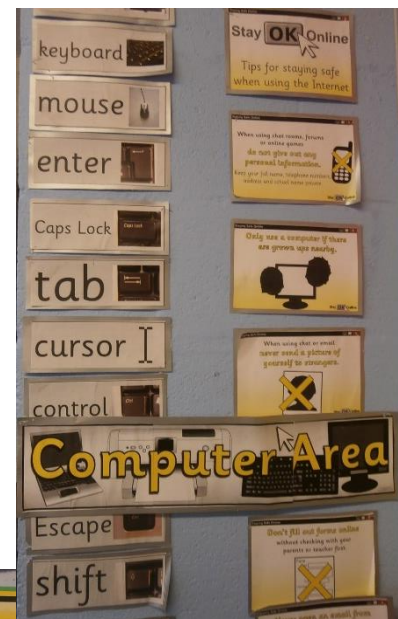
Improving Outcomes for our Students

Please read **with** and **to** your child. Talk about any 'new' words you come across and try to use them at home.





Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare

- To help support students in recognising their own feelings and emotions and identify ways to manage these.

We will be using the language of 'Zones' as shown in the picture below, to help students identify which zone they are in and then how to help themselves move to the 'ready to learn' green zone.
