Thriftwood College is a vibrant and outstanding Special School where the wellbeing and achievement of every pupil is our priority. The role of Learning Mentor enables students to work towards overcoming social, emotional and learning difficulties which act as barriers to learning. They bridge academic and pastoral support roles ensuring that individual pupils and students participate more effectively in their own learning and prepare them well for adult life and independent living. The barriers to learning can be wide ranging and often very personal to the individual pupil. A young person may be going through complex transitions and changes in their own lives, within the family or at college. Learning Mentors help to identify these issues and help them to address what it is that is getting in the way of their learning.

The role includes:

- Working in partnership with the Class Teachers/Tutors to support and enable students with Special Educational Needs (moderate learning difficulties) to access learning and the curriculum in line with Thriftwood School & College policies.
- Offering 'hover' support during lessons and one to one mentoring as required
- Establishing relationship with parents to ensure continuity of approach
