We have an open-door policy at school; have all your questions, queries and communications been answered in a timely and appropriate manner?





100% said yes (same as last year)




Do you feel that you are kept well informed about your child's academic and social progress?





If you access Tapestry, is it useful in finding out what your child is doing at school?




